

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the the B1077 Station Road from a point 172 metres north of its junction with U31707 Maurice Gaymer Road to a point 20 metres north of its junction with 3P154 Wymbur Drive in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH because of carriageway resurfacing.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 07:00 hours on 30th June 2018 to 19:00 hours on 1st July 2018 for the duration of the works, expected to be 2 days within the period. (This is a full 24 hour closure with night time working. Closure will be flipped to allow access onto Maurice Gaymer Road once south side of works completed which will allow vehicular access to Travis Perkins on 30th June 2018 from northern side of rail crossing).

Alternative route is via: North bound; B1077 Station Road/ Connaught Road /Exchange Street/ Queens Road/ Blackthorn Road, A11, A1075 Norwich Road, A1066 Hurth Way/ Mundford Road/ Thetford Road/ The Street/ Diss Road/ Low Road/ High Road/ Stanley Road, B1077 Denmark Street/ Shelfanger Road/ Church Road/ Winfarthing Road/ Diss Road/ Mill Road/ Short Green/ Mile Road/ Haugh Road/ New Buckenham Road/ Cake Street/ The Green/ Attleborough Road/ Buckenham Road/Station Road.

South bound; B1077 Station Road/ Buckenham Road/ Attleborough Road/ The Green/ Cake Street/ New Buckenham Road/ Haugh Road/ Mile Road/ Short Green/ Mill Road/ Diss Road/ Winfarthing Road/ Church Road/ Shelfanger Road/ Denmark Street, A1066 Stanley Road/ High Road/ Low Road/ Diss Road/ The Street/ Thetford Road/ Mundford Road/ Hurth Way, A1075 Norwich Road, A11, B1077 Ellingham Road/ Queens Road/ Church Street/ Surrogate Street/ Station Road (Attleborough/ Riddlesworth/ Brettenham/ Croxton/ Banham/ Quidenham/ Bressingham/ Roydon/ Diss/ Heywood/ Garboldisham/ New Buckenham/ South Lopham/ Old Buckenham/ Shelfanger/ Harling/ Roudham and Larling/ Thetford/ Snetterton/ Bridgham/ Kilverstone/ North Lopham/ Winfarthing).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
