PROPOSED TRAFFIC ORDER AND NOTICE

The Norfolk County Council propose to make the following Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

The NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (ATTLEBOROUGH, LONDON ROAD)
(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) AMENDMENT ORDER 2018

To prohibit any vehicle from exceeding 30 miles per hour along the length of road specified in the Schedule below, which will be an extension to the current 30 miles per hour speed limit.

The Norfolk County Council (Attleborough, Various Roads) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2013 will be amended by the addition of the length of road set out in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and plan, together with a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at Norfolk County Council, County Hall, Norwich, and at the offices of Breckland District Council, Elizabeth House, Walpole Loke, Dereham, NR19 1EE during normal office hours.

DEVELOPMENT ACCESS ROAD SPEED TABLE NOTICE 2018

As required under the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 and Section 90(A), (C) and (D) of the Highways Act 1980, notice is hereby given that Norfolk County Council proposes to install a flat-topped speed table on the Development Access Estate Road (USRN Labels 04000683) at a point 9 metres northwest of the centreline of its junction with the C572 London Road.

The speed table will have constructed dimensions of 75mm in height, 7 metres in length and will cross the full width of the delineated carriageway. The speed table will be bounded by 1.0 metre ramps at each end of its 7 metre length.

The reason for the speed table proposal is to provide a safer environment within a residential area. It is also part of a wider scheme to improve the existing transport

network within Attleborough to support the planned housing and development growth and resolve some of the current transport problems.
