We **will** be able to accept the following types of hazardous waste free of charge:

- ✓ Aerosols
- ✓ Fire extinguishers
- ✓ Garden pesticides and fertilizers
- ✓ Household chemicals and cleansers
- ✓ Paint
- ✓ Photographic chemicals
- ✓ Wood preservatives, treatments and varnishes

✗ can't

Unfortunately, **we will not** be able to accept:

- ✗ Ammunition, explosives or marine flares
- ✗ Asbestos
- ✗ Commercial hazardous waste
- ✗ Fireworks
- ✗ Gas canisters (full or part-full)
- ✗ Petrol, diesel or any other fuels

Advice to householders visiting amnesty days

1. Products for disposal should be kept in their original containers and not mixed together.
2. Containers should be clearly labelled where possible.
3. When transporting hazardous waste make sure it is properly sealed to avoid leakage.
