

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C139 Besthorpe Road from its junction with B1077 Norwich Road for a distance of 40 metres eastwards in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH because of works to remove a traffic island for footway widening.

This Order continues the provisions of the Order dated 13<sup>th</sup> September 2018 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 9<sup>th</sup> November 2018 to 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2018 (previously 8<sup>th</sup> November 2018) for the duration of the works, expected to be about 14 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: C139 Besthorpe Road, U33176 Thieves Lane, B1077 Connaught Road/ Exchange Street/ Church Street and vice versa.

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

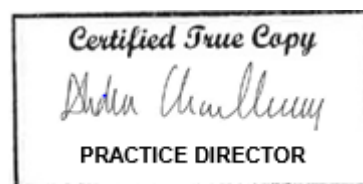

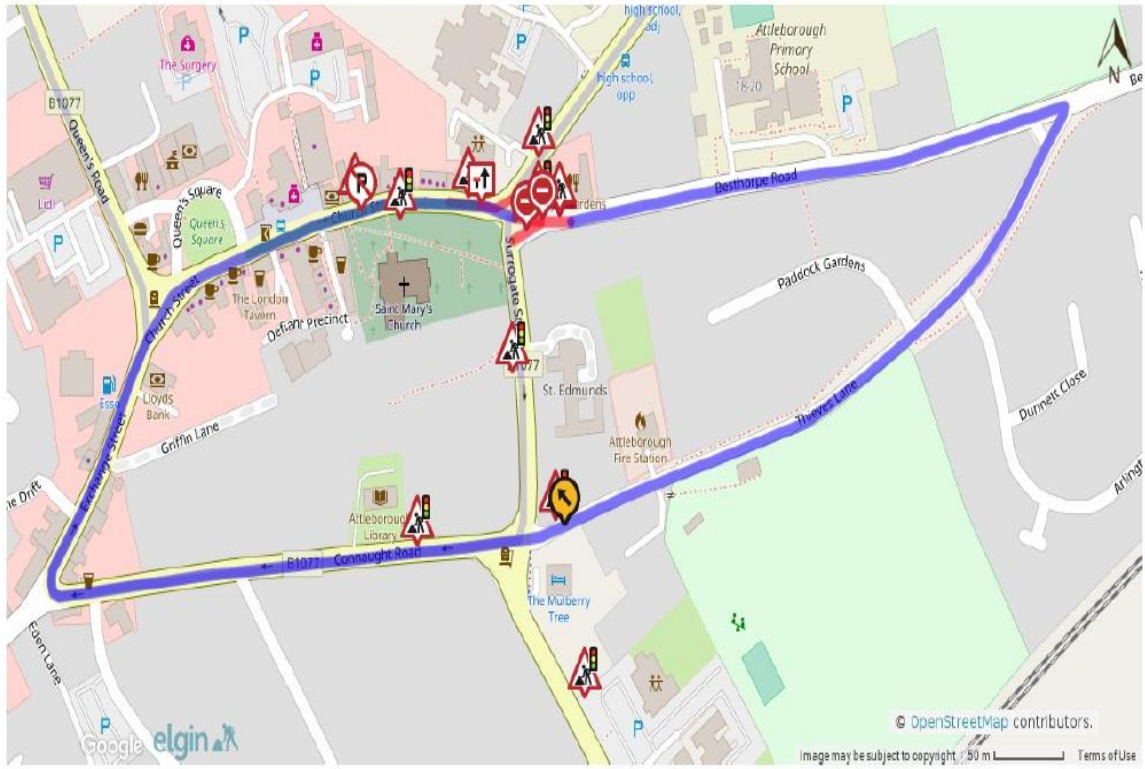
