## NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (ATTLEBOROUGH) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2018 ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)

ORDER continuing to restrict the following roads as follows:-

- 1) prohibiting the use by vehicles of the B1077 Surrogate Street from its junction with C139 Besthorpe Road to its junction with B1077 Station Road (hereinafter referred to as the said road (a));
- prohibiting the use by vehicles of the B1077 Station Road from its junction with U31707 Maurice Gaymer Road to its junction with B1077 Connaught Road (hereinafter referred to as the said road (b));
- prohibiting the use by vehicles of the B1077 Connaught Road from its junction with B1077 Station Road to its junction with C572 High Street (hereinafter referred to as the said road (c));
- 4) prohibiting the use by vehicles of the U33176 Thieves Lane from its junction with U33408 Arlington Gardens to its junction with B1077 Station Road (hereinafter referred to as the said road (d);
- 5) temporarily suspending the one-way restriction (eastbound) on B1077 Connaught Road from its junction with B1077 Station Road to its junction with C572 High Street (hereinafter referred to as the said road (e);

## in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that carriageway resurfacing continues to be required at the said roads (a) (b) (c) and (d) in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH and that in consequence with effect from 19:00 hours on 30th November 2018 to 06:00 hours on 1st December 2018 (previously 06:00 hours on 30th November 2018):
  - (i) traffic over the said roads (a) (b) (c) and (d) should continue to be prohibited; and
  - (ii) traffic over the said road (e) should continue to be subject to a temporary suspension of the one-way restriction (eastbound) to allow vehicles to travel in both an easterly and westerly direction;

for the duration of the works expected to be about 1 night within the period.

- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
- 3. The following Order will become suspended where it conflicts with the provisions of this Order and during the operation of this Order as follows:-

The Norfolk County Council (Attleborough, Various Roads) (One-Way) Consolidation Order 2011

4. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 19:00 hours on 30th November 2018 to 06:00 hours on 1st December 2018 for the duration of the works the said roads (a) (b) (c) and (d) SHALL CONTINUE TO NOT BE USED by any class of vehicle and the said road (e) SHALL CONTINUE TO BE SUBJECT to a temporary suspension of the one-way restriction (eastbound).
