The Chairman invited members of the Public to speak and points raised included the following:

- An allotment tenant requested a map of the site. It was confirmed no formal map was available, however, an informal site sketch was being prepared and could be available.
- A resident asked for an update regarding the drainage problems at Gaymers Meadow. It was confirmed a meeting had taken place and a further site meeting deferred due to holiday; date to be confirmed.
- An Allotment tenant questioned policy for pro rata rent. It was confirmed no discount is offered on the yearly rent because of the demand for plots.
- An allotment tenant commented on the state of the allotments and questioned how the allotments were inspected. It was confirmed, the allotments are inspected regularly by the Groundsmen and following a further recent inspection, tenants would be receiving a letter if they are not abiding by the rules and regulations.
- An allotment holder advised on an article he had regarding beekeeping regulations which he would forward to the Council and the allotment in question may not be suitable for bee keeping.
- A Resident asked if Attleborough Town Council intended to involve the Primary Schools with the London Road Masterplan. It was confirmed a dedicated meeting would be needed to look at further details but this could be considered.
- A resident mentioned the Football club was given 2 months to resolve the issue. The Clerk confirmed there was ongoing negotiation.
