

In September 2018, work commenced on the first phase of the £4.5m Transport for Attleborough project which aims to improve all forms of transport and support planned growth within the town.

This first phase is nearing completion and includes improvements to pedestrian facilities, installation of new pedestrian crossings, road resurfacing, installation of new traffic lights, and the widening and conversion of Surrogate Street to two-way traffic.

These works are due to be completed early December and Surrogate Street will be opened to two-way traffic on Wednesday 5 December from approximately 10am. From Wednesday onwards, vehicles approaching from Station Road will be able to access Surrogate Street from its southern end and travel northwards towards the A11. Traffic from Station Road will need to give way to vehicles travelling from Surrogate Street to Connaught Road.
