Alternative route is via: B1077 Queens Road, U33189 Queens Square.


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 6 months from the date of the Order).

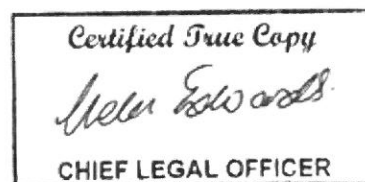



ORDER prohibiting the use by the public of footpath 3F659 Queens Road to Infant School from its junction with B1077 Queens Road for a distance of 190 metres to its end point in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH

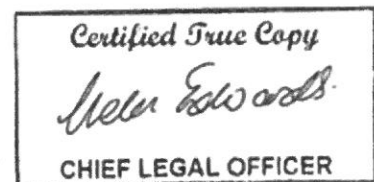
WHEREAS the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that improvement works are required at the footpath 3F659 Queens Road to Infant School from its junction with B1077 Queens Road for a distance of 190 metres to its end point in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH (hereinafter referred to as the said footpath) and that the use of the said footpath should be prohibited with effect from 29th July 2019 to 30th August 2019 for the duration of the works (if necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 6 months from the date of this Order)

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 29th July 2019 to 30th August 2019 for the duration of the works the said footpath SHALL NOT BE USED by the public
