(CARLETON RODE) (EMERGENCY NOTICE)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION 2019
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to a burst water main the use by vehicles of the B1113 The Turnpike from its junction with the C350 Ugate Street for a distance of 100m eastwards in the PARISH OF CARLETON RODE will be temporarily prohibited from 9th July 2019 to 12th July 2019 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 4 days within the period. If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.


Alternative route is via: B1113 The Turnpike, B1113 Norwich Road, C594 Wymondham Road, C594 The Street, C594 Silfield Road, C594 Station Road, B1172 London Road, B1077 Attleborough Road, B1077 The Green, B1077 Cake Street, B1077 New Buckenham Road, B1113 Castle Hill Road, B1113 King Street, B1113 Queen Street (Wymondham/ Spooner Row/ Carleton Rode/ Old Buckenham/ Ashwellthorpe and Fundenhall/ Tacolneston/ Morley/ Bunwell/ Besthorpe/ Attleborough/ Forncett/ New Buckenham).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
