

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the 1) B1077 Connaught Plain from its junction with B1077 Connaught Road to its junction with C572 High Street; and 2) the B1077 Connaught Road from its junction with B1077 Surrogate Street/ Station Road to its junction with B1077 Connaught Plain in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH because of works to reconstruct a traffic island and kerb lines.

The road (a) will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the road (b) will be subject to the temporary imposition of a 7.5T weight restriction (HGVs and Buses) from 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 to 8<sup>th</sup> November 2019 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 67 days within the period.

Alternative route is:- Anticlockwise (for light vehicles): B1077 Exchange Street/ Queens Road, U33119 Blackthorn Road, A11 Attleborough Bypass, C572 London Road, High Street; and

Anticlockwise (HGVs / Buses only): B1077 Surrogate Street/ Norwich Road, A11 Trunk Road, B1172 Spooner Row slip/ London Road/ Station Road/ Spooner Row slip, A11 Trunk Road, C572 London Road/ High Street (Attleborough/ Wymondham).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

## NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (ATTLEBOROUGH) **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2019 ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)**

## ORDER:-

- prohibiting the use by vehicles of the B1077 Connaught Plain from its junction 1) with B1077 Connaught Road to its junction with C572 High Street (hereinafter referred to as the said road (a)); and
- imposing a temporary 7.5 tonne weight restriction (HGVs and Buses) on the 2) B1077 Connaught Road from its junction with B1077 Surrogate Street/ Station Road to its junction with B1077 Connaught Plain (hereinafter referred to as the said road (b)):

## in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH

- Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County 1. Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that reconstruction of a traffic island and kerb lines are required at the said roads (a) and (b) and that in consequence with effect from 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 to 8th November 2019 for the duration of the works expected to be about 67 days within the period:
  - traffic over the said road (a) should be prohibited; and (i)
  - a temporary 7.5 tonne weight restriction (HGVs and Buses) be (ii) imposed on the said road (b).
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which 2. requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
- This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon 3. completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 to 8<sup>th</sup> November 2019 for the duration of the works the said road (a) SHALL NOT BE USED by any class of vehicle and the said road SHALL BE SUBJECT TO the temporary imposition of a 7.5 tonne weight restriction.
