Transport for Attleborough High Street / Exchange Street junction – weekend/overnight closures

As part of the ongoing £4.5m Transport for Attleborough (TfA) project, which is set to improve all forms of transport and support planned growth in the town, work is currently ongoing to improve the junction of High Street and Exchange Street in Attleborough. These changes will allow traffic to flow more smoothly and make it easier for pedestrians to cross the road.

The final phase of the High Street / Exchange Street project will be to resurface the carriageway to provide a smooth and safe surface for road users. To minimise disruption this work will be carried out during one weekend and over two weeknights. The junction of Connaught Road, High Street and Exchange Street will need to be closed to allow this work to take place swiftly and safely.

The road will be closed and diversion routes in place on the following dates and times:

- From 7am Saturday 26 October until 6am Monday 28 October
- From 7pm Monday 28 October until 6am Tuesday 29 October
- From 7pm Tuesday 29 October until 6am Wednesday 30 October

During the road closure access to properties will be retained and Connaught Road and Exchange Street will be temporarily converted to two-way to facilitate this. A signed diversion route will be in place throughout the road closures. Please see the attached diversion route plan for details.

We may also need to close the right turn from Connaught Road to Exchange Street between 14 October and 18 October, to allow our contractors to work safely within the carriageway. However, we are currently trying to find alternative arrangements to avoid the need for this particular section of road closure.

The County Council thanks people for their patience whilst these improvements are carried out. The work will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
