(ATTLEBOROUGH) (URGENT NOTICE)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION 2019
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to track repairs the use by vehicles of the B1077 Station Road from a point 205 metres north of U31707 Maurice Gaymer Road for a distance of 30 metres northwards in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH will be temporarily prohibited from 23:00 hours on 9th October 2019 to 06:00 hours on 10th October 2019 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 7 hours within the period. If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 5 days.



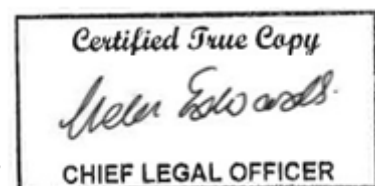
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

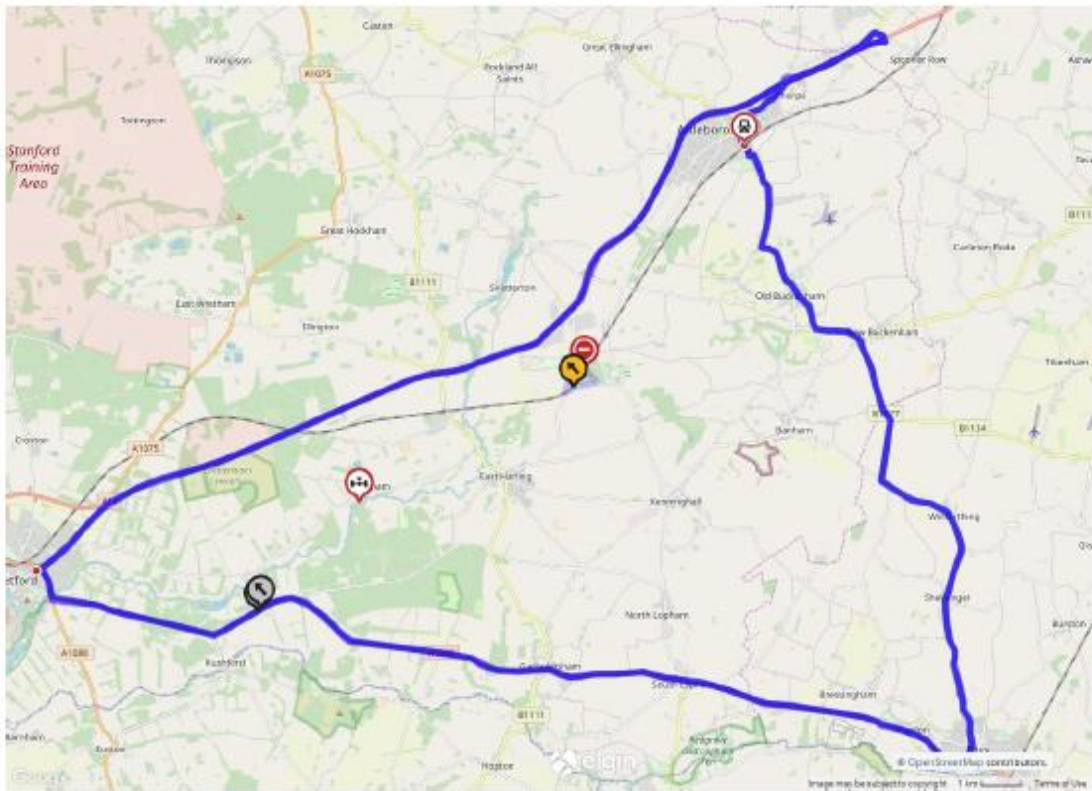
