

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C139 Bunwell Road from a point 635 metres east of its junction with U33095 School Lane for a distance of 250 metres eastwards in the PARISH OF BESTHORPE because of works to install BT ducting.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 13th November 2019 to 15th November 2019 for the duration of the works, expected to be 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: West bound - C139 Bunwell Road, C572 Besthorpe Road, U33096 Mill Lane, B1077 Norwich Road, A11, B1172 London Road, B1172/ C140 Station Road, C140 Bunwell Road; East bound - C139 Bunwell Road, C140 Bunwell Road, C140/ B1172 Station Road, A11, B1077 Norwich Road, U33096 Mill Lane, C572 Besthorpe Road, C139 Bunwell Road (Spooner Row/ Besthorpe/ Attleborough).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (BESTHORPE) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2019 ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)

ORDER prohibiting the use by vehicles of the C139 Bunwell Road from a point 635 metres east of its junction with U33095 School Lane for a distance of 250 metres eastwards in the PARISH OF BESTHORPE

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that:-
 - (i) works to install BT ducting are required at the C139 Bunwell Road from a point 635 metres east of its junction with U33095 School Lane for a distance of 250 metres eastwards in the PARISH OF BESTHORPE (hereinafter referred to as the said road) and:
 - (ii) that in consequence traffic over the said road should be prohibited with effect from 13th November 2019 to 15th November 2019 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
- 3. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 13th November 2019 to 15th November 2019 for the duration of the works the said road SHALL NOT BE USED by any class of vehicle.
