

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the 1) B1077 Church Street from its junction with B1077 Exchange Street to its junction with B1077 Norwich Road; 2) B1077 Church Street from its junction with B1077 Queens Road to its junction with B1077 Norwich Road; 3) B1077 Exchange Street from its junction with B1077 Queens Road (outbound lane) to its junction with B1077 Queens Road (inbound lane) and U33189 Queens Square; 4) B1077 Exchange Street from its junction with B1077 Queens Road (outbound lane) to its junction with B1077 Queens Road (inbound lane); in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH because of kerbing, paving and ducting works on behalf of Norfolk County Council.

Vehicles using the road 1) will be temporarily prohibited to park, stop or load/unload from 3rd February 2020 to 17th April 2020; and the roads 2), 3) and 4) will be temporarily closed (except for access) at the following dates and times: 2) between 08:00 and 18:00 hours on 29th March 2020 and 5th April 2020; 3) between 19:00 and 23:00 hours from 5th February 2020 to 6th February 2020; and 4) from 6th February 2020 to 3rd March 2020; for the duration of the works only whilst signs indicating the closures are in place.

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).


Alternative route is via:- B1077 Norwich Road, A11, A11 Spooner Row interchange, B1172 London Road/ Station Road, A11, B1077 Queens Road (Spooner Row/ Besthorpe/ Attleborough).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

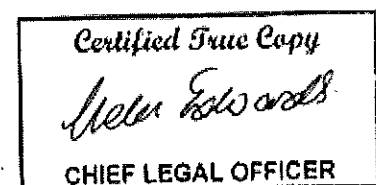

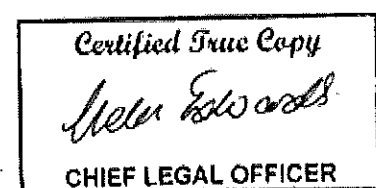

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2020  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)**

ORDER temporarily restricting the use by vehicles of the:-

- 1) B1077 Church Street from its junction with B1077 Exchange Street to its junction with B1077 Norwich Road (hereinafter referred to as the said road (a));
- 2) B1077 Church Street from its junction with B1077 Queens Road to its junction with B1077 Norwich Road (hereinafter referred to as the said road (b));
- 3) B1077 Exchange Street from its junction with B1077 Queens Road (outbound lane) to its junction with B1077 Queens Road (inbound lane) and U33189 Queens Square (hereinafter referred to as the said road (c));
- 4) B1077 Exchange Street from its junction with B1077 Queens Road (outbound lane) to its junction with B1077 Queens Road (inbound lane) (hereinafter referred to as the said road (d));


in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that kerbing, paving and ducting works on behalf of Norfolk County Council are required at the said roads (a) (b) (c) and (d) in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH and that in consequence the following restrictions will be in place at the times and dates below:-
  - (i) traffic over the said road (a) will be temporarily prohibited to park, stop or load/unload from 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2020 to 17<sup>th</sup> April 2020;
  - (ii) traffic over the said road (b) should be prohibited with effect between 08:00 and 18:00 hours on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2020 and 5<sup>th</sup> April 2020;
  - (iii) traffic over the said road (c) should be prohibited with effect between 19:00 and 23:00 hours from 5<sup>th</sup> February 2020 to 6<sup>th</sup> February 2020; and
  - (iv) traffic over the said road (d) should be prohibited with effect from 6<sup>th</sup> February 2020 to 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2020;for the duration of the works only whilst signs indicating the closures are in place.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
3. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational

period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2020 to 19<sup>th</sup> June 2020 for the duration of the works the said road (a) SHALL BE RESTRICTED insofar as the parking or loading/unloading of vehicles will be PROHIBITED and the said roads (b), (c) and (d) SHALL NOT BE USED by any class of vehicle.
