

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the 1) U33189 Queens Square from its eastern junction with B1077 Church Street to its western junction with B1077 Church Street; 2) B1077 Queens Road from a point 30 metres north of its junction with U33189 Queens Square to its junction with U33189 Queens Square; 3) B1077 Exchange Street from its junction with C572 High Street to its junction with B1077 Church Street; 4) U33189 Queens Square from a point 20 metres east of its junction with B1077 Queens Road for a distance of 55 metres eastwards; and 5) B1077 Church Street from its junction with B1077 Queens Road to its junction with B1077 Norwich Road; in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH because of kerbing, paving and ducting works on behalf of Norfolk County Council.

The road 1) will be temporarily subject to a suspension of the one-way restriction (westbound) and vehicles will be temporarily prohibited to park, stop or load/unload; and a 20mph speed restriction will be imposed over the roads 2) 3) 4) and 5) from 3rd February 2020 to 19th June 2020 for the duration of the works.


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

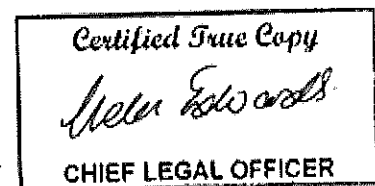



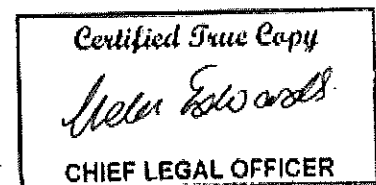

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2020
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)**

ORDER temporarily restricting the use by vehicles of the:-

- 1) U33189 Queens Square from its eastern junction with B1077 Church Street to its western junction with B1077 Church Street (hereinafter referred to as the said road (a));
- 2) B1077 Queens Road from a point 30 metres north of its junction with U33189 Queens Square to its junction with U33189 Queens Square (hereinafter referred to as the said road (b));
- 3) B1077 Exchange Street from its junction with C572 High Street to its junction with B1077 Church Street (hereinafter referred to as the said road (c));
- 4) U33189 Queens Square from a point 20 metres east of its junction with B1077 Queens Road for a distance of 55 metres eastwards (hereinafter referred to as the said road (d)); and
- 5) B1077 Church Street from its junction with B1077 Queens Road to its junction with B1077 Norwich Road (hereinafter referred to as the said road (e)); and

in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that kerbing, paving and ducting works on behalf of Norfolk County Council are required at the said roads (a) (b) (c) (d) and (e) in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH and that in consequence with effect from 3rd February 2020 to 19th June 2020 for the duration of the works:-
 - (i) traffic over the said road (a) should be subject to a temporary suspension of the one-way system (westbound) to allow vehicles to travel in both an easterly and westerly direction;
 - (ii) traffic over the said road (a) will be temporarily prohibited to park, stop or load/unload; and
 - (iii) a 20mph speed restriction will be imposed over the said roads (b) (c) (d) and (e).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
3. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 3rd February 2020 to 19th June 2020 for the duration of the works the said road (a) SHALL BE SUBJECT to a temporary suspension of the one-way restriction (westbound) and SHALL BE RESTRICTED insofar as the parking or loading/unloading of vehicles will be PROHIBITED and the said roads (b), (c), (d) and (e) SHALL BE SUBJECT to the imposition of a 20mph Speed Restriction.
