

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the B1077 Church Street from its junction with B1077 Exchange Street to its junction with B1077 Norwich Road the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH because of NCC kerbing, paving and ducting works.

This Order continues the provisions of the Order dated 30<sup>th</sup> January 2020 that vehicles using the said road will be subject to a temporary restriction of parking, loading and unloading from 18<sup>th</sup> April 2020 to 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020 (previously 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2020 to 17<sup>th</sup> April 2020) for the duration of the works, expected to be about 45 days within the period.


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
