## NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (ATTLEBOROUGH) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2020 ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)

ORDER prohibiting the use by vehicles of Exchange Street from its junction with Queens Road to its junction with Church Street in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH

- Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that:-
  - (i) resurfacing and engineering works are required at Exchange Street from its junction with Queens Road to its junction with Church Street in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH (hereinafter referred to as the said road) and:
  - (ii) that in consequence traffic over the said road should be prohibited with effect from 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2020 to 14<sup>th</sup> August 2020 for the duration of the works expected to be about 12 days within the period.
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
- 3. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2020 to 14<sup>th</sup> August 2020 for the duration of the works the said road SHALL NOT BE USED by any class of vehicle.
