- Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that:-
 - (i) Anglian Water works to install double boundary box are required at the U33092 Whitehouse Lane from a point 605 metres south of its junction with the C139 Bunwell Road to a point 380 metres north of its junction with the B1077 Station Road/Buckenham Road in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH (hereinafter referred to as the said road) and:
 - (ii) that in consequence traffic over the said road should be prohibited with effect from 10th September 2020 to 13th September 2020 for the duration of the works expected to be about 4 days within the period.
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
- 3. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.
