

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the B1113 The Turnpike from its junction with the U76089 Church Lane for a distance of 233 metres north east in the PARISH OF BUNWELL because of works for a new water connection.

This Order continues the provisions of the Order dated 19th November 2020 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 25th November 2020 to 26th November 2020 (previously 23rd November 2020 to 24th November 2020) for the duration of the works expected to be about 2 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: B1113 The Turnpike, B1113 Norwich Road, C594 Wymondham Road, C594 The Street, C594 Silfield Road, C594 Station Road, B1172 London Road, B1077 Surrogate Street, B1077 Buckenham Road, B1077 Attleborough Road, B1077 Cake Street, B1077 New Buckenham Road, B1113 Castle Hill Road, B1113 King Street, B1113 Queen Street, B1113 Market Place (Spooner Row/ Carleton Rode/ Ashwellthorpe and Fundenhall/ Tacolneston/ Morley/ Attleborough/ Forncett/ New Buckenham/ Wymondham/ Old Buckenham/ Besthorpe).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
