NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (ATTLEBOROUGH)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2020
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)

ORDER restricting the use by vehicles of the C572 London Road from its junction with the U33121 Chapel Road to its junction with the C137 West Carr Road in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH

1. Save as provided in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that:-
 - (i) surfacing and improvement works are required at the C572 London Road from its junction with the U33121 Chapel Road to its junction with the C137 West Carr Road in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH (hereinafter referred to as the said road) and:
 - (ii) that in consequence, traffic over the said road will be temporarily prohibited to park, stop or load/unload with effect from 23rd November 2020 to 22nd March 2021 for the duration of the works expected to be about 120 days within the period.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply:
 - (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer;
 - (b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which this Order applies.
3. The following Order will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Order and during the operation of this Order as follows:-

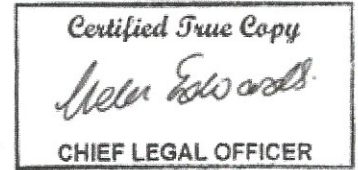
The Norfolk County Council (Attleborough, Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2014
4. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 23rd November 2020 to 22nd March 2021 for the duration of the works the said road SHALL BE RESTRICTED insofar as the parking or loading/unloading of vehicles will be PROHIBITED.

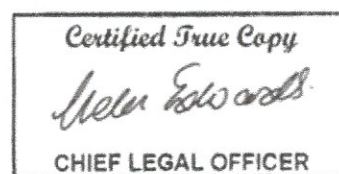
