Important roadworks information

Dear Sir/Madam

A11 between Thetford and Attleborough: resurfacing

I write to inform you that we'll be carrying out essential resurfacing works between the above locations. During this work, we'll also be renewing faded road markings and replacing damaged signage and road studs.

We plan to complete these works over **5 months**, from **4 January** to **28 May**, subject to weather conditions.

Due to the extensive amount of work on this project, we have split the works into two phases. We have closely liaised with the local authority to agree the most suitable diversion routes for each phase as detailed below:

Phase 1: A11 lane closures between Thetford and Attleborough, in both directions, starting Monday 4 January to Monday 18 January (2 weeks)

 Whilst the road will remain open, there will be lane closures on the A11 between Thetford and Attleborough. (Diagram 1)

Phase 2(a): A11 overnight closures (8pm – 6am) between A1075 Roundabout Thetford and Fen St Roundabout, Attleborough, in both directions, starting Monday 18 January to Sunday 31 January (2 weeks)

Phase 2(b): A11 two-way traffic system will be in place, while works will be undertaken throughout the day and night, starting Monday 1 February to Monday 29 March (8 weeks)

Phase 2(c): A11 overnight closures (8pm – 6am) between A1075 Roundabout Thetford and Ellingham Junction, Attleborough, in both directions, starting Monday 29 March to Friday 28 May (9 weeks)

- Southbound traffic will be diverted from Thickthorn Junction via the A47/Norwich Southern Bypass and follow the A140, then the A1066 before rejoining the A11 at Thetford.
- Northbound traffic will follow the same route but in reverse. (Diagram 2)

The diversion route will need to be used during the full closures only.



