

**NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (ATTLEBOROUGH)**  
**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION CONTINUATION ORDER 2021**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)**

ORDER continuing the prohibition of the use by the public of the:-  
1) 3F40 Paddock Gardens To Besthorpe Road (hereinafter referred to as the said footpath (a));  
2) 3F40 Paddock Gardens to Linked Footway (hereinafter referred to as the said footpath (b));  
3) C139 Besthorpe Road from 10m west of 3F40 Paddock Gardens to Besthorpe Road for 20m eastwards (hereinafter referred to as the said road (c)); and  
4) U31114 Paddock Gardens from 10m east of 3F40 Paddock Gardens to Linked Footway to 10m east of 3F40 Paddock Gardens To Besthorpe Road (hereinafter referred to as the said road (d));  
in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH

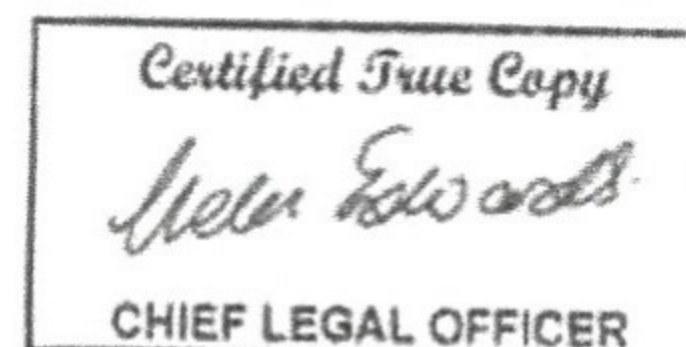
1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that footway reconstruction works continue to be required at the said footpaths (a) and (b) in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH and that in consequence, with effect from 15<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021 (previously 10<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> May 2021):-
  - (i) the use by the public of the said footpaths (a) and (b) should continue to be prohibited; and
  - (ii) traffic using the said roads (c) and (d) will continue to be temporarily prohibited from parking, stopping and loading/unloading vehicles;for the duration of the works expected to be about 14 days within the period.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
3. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 15<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021 for the duration of the works the said footpaths (a) and (b) SHALL CONTINUE TO NOT BE USED by members of the public; and traffic using the said roads (c) and (d) SHALL CONTINUE TO BE RESTRICTED insofar as the parking, stopping or loading/unloading of vehicles will be PROHIBITED.



**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)**

ORDER continuing the prohibition of the use by the public of the:-  
1) 3F40 Paddock Gardens To Besthorpe Road (hereinafter referred to as the said footpath (a));  
2) 3F40 Paddock Gardens to Linked Footway (hereinafter referred to as the said footpath (b));  
3) C139 Besthorpe Road from 10m west of 3F40 Paddock Gardens to Besthorpe Road for 20m eastwards (hereinafter referred to as the said road (c)); and  
4) U31114 Paddock Gardens from 10m east of 3F40 Paddock Gardens to Linked Footway to 10m east of 3F40 Paddock Gardens To Besthorpe Road (hereinafter referred to as the said road (d));  
in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that footway reconstruction works continue to be required at the said footpaths (a) and (b) in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH and that in consequence, with effect from 15<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021 (previously 10<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> May 2021):-
  - (i) the use by the public of the said footpaths (a) and (b) should continue to be prohibited; and
  - (ii) traffic using the said roads (c) and (d) will continue to be temporarily prohibited from parking, stopping and loading/unloading vehicles;for the duration of the works expected to be about 14 days within the period.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
3. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 15<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021 for the duration of the works the said footpaths (a) and (b) SHALL CONTINUE TO NOT BE USED by members of the public; and traffic using the said roads (c) and (d) SHALL CONTINUE TO BE RESTRICTED insofar as the parking, stopping or loading/unloading of vehicles will be PROHIBITED.
