NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the 1) C139 Bunwell Road from 10m west of its junction with U33092 White House Lane for 40m eastwards; and 2) U33092 White House Lane from its junction with C139 Bunwell Road for 50m southwards; in the PARISH OF BESTHORPE because of carriageway patching works.
