

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the U33114 Deopham Road from its junction with B1077 Attleborough Road for 50m northwards in the PARISH OF GREAT ELLINGHAM because of carriageway resurfacing works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 28<sup>th</sup> August to 10<sup>th</sup> September 2021 for the duration of the works expected to be about 14 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: U33114 Deopham Road, U33115 Tanyard Lane, U33144 Hill Common, B1077 Ellingham Road/Attleborough Road and vice versa (Attleborough, Great Ellingham).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

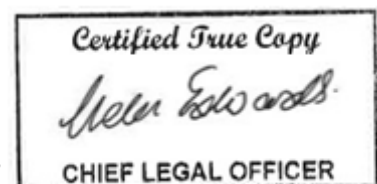

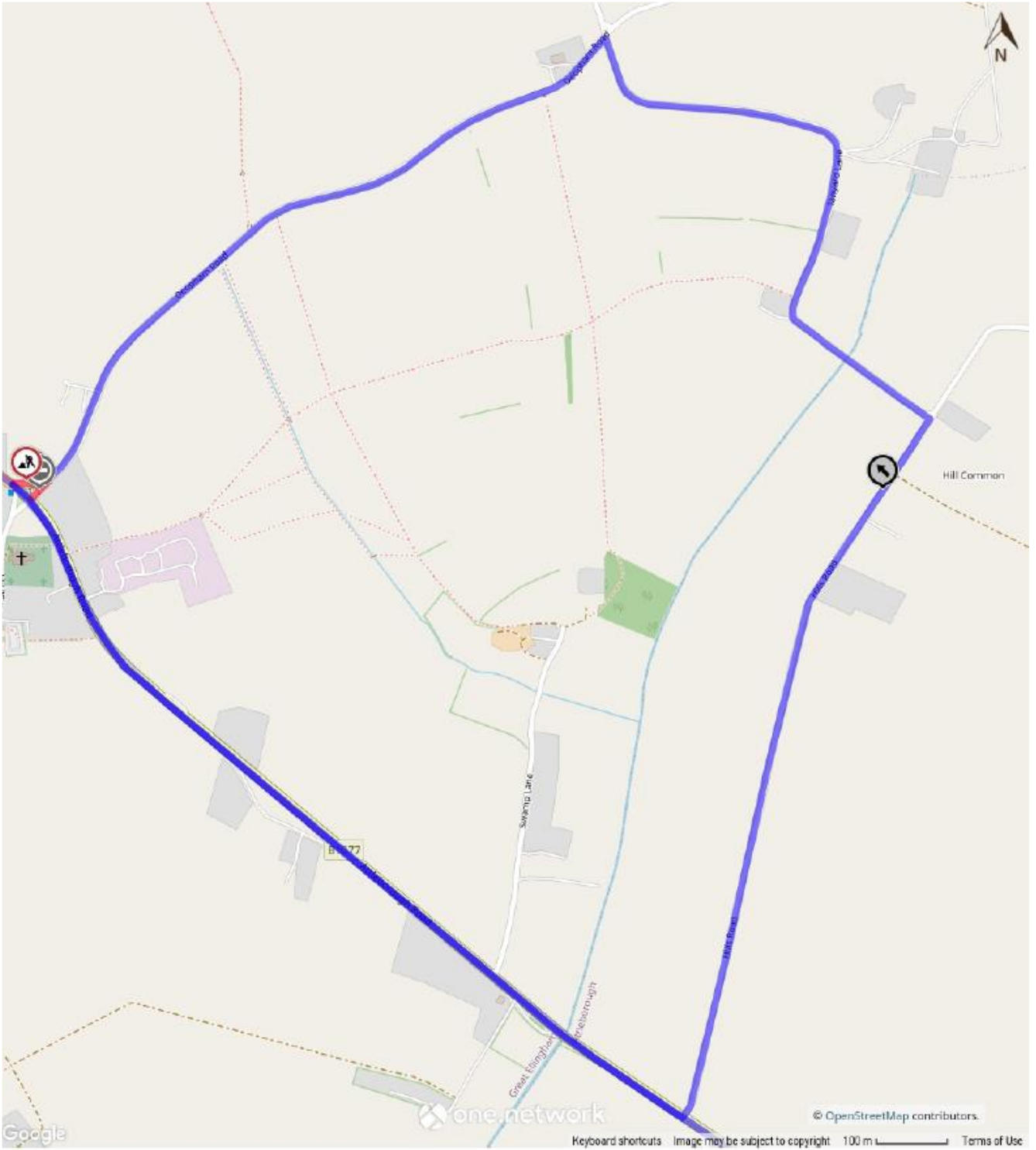
