

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the U33119 Carvers Lane from its junction with U31502 Blackthorn Road for 10m westwards in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH because of new gas main installation works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 4th to 8th October 2021 for the duration of the works expected to be about 5 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Westbound – U33119 Carvers Lane, C137 West Carr Road, C572 London Road/High Street/Connaught Plain, B1077 Exchange Street/Queens Road, U33119 Blackthorn Road. Eastbound – U33119 Blackthorn Road, B1077 Ellingham Road/Queens Road/Queens Square/Church Street/Suttogate Street/Connaught Road/Connaught Plain, C572 Connaught Plain/High Street/London Road, C137 West Carr Road, U33119 Carvers Lane.


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

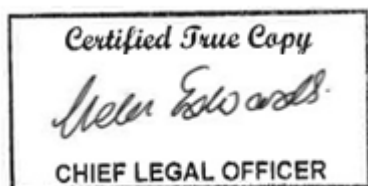
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

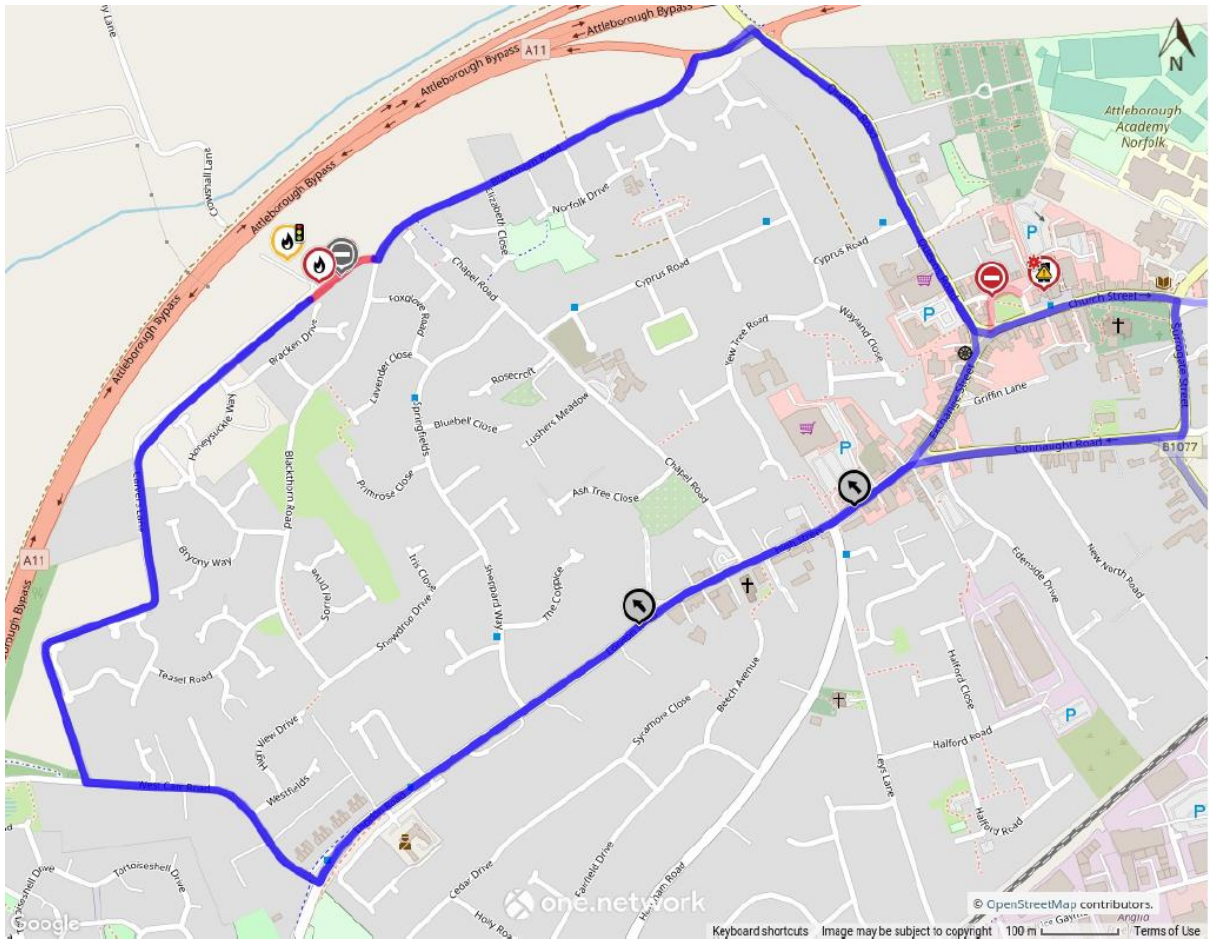
