

A11 Spooner Row to Thickthorn concrete road reconstruction and surface repairs

Advanced Notification of Weekend Closure - A11 Spooner Row to Thickthorn Concrete Reconstruction and Surface Repairs Scheme

I am writing to let you know that there will be a full weekend closure of the southbound carriageway of the A11 between Thickthorn and Spooner Row, from 8pm on Friday 19 November, through until 6am on Monday 22 November.

The weekend closure is required to allow our team to undertake repairs to the concrete surface for phase 1 of the scheme (A11 Tuttle Interchange to Thickthorn), as well as preparatory works for phase 2 of the scheme (A11 Spooner Row to Tuttle Interchange). The A11 will only be closed in one direction during this time.

By undertaking the work over a weekend, we will save several weeks' worth of overnight closures that would be required to do the same activity, due to the increased working window.

The A11 closures will be supported by a signed diversion route that will take traffic along the B1172, and we will also encourage larger vehicles to use a dispersal route along the A1066 and A140. Signs will be placed at numerous points to inform drivers associated with the site works to take care in residential areas along the diversion route.

I apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your patience whilst we carry out this important repair work.

Keeping the community updated

We've sent a letter to every home within a 150m radius of the diversion route to ensure customers are aware of the expected increase of traffic overnight. We've also sent a letter to all properties within a 500m radius of the scheme, so they are informed in advance of our construction activities. And we've also provided them with a 24/7 telephone number and email address for the project, so they can get in contact if required.
