

A11 Spooner Row to Thickthorn concrete road reconstruction and surface repairs

Phase 2 - A11 Spooner Row to Tuttlles concrete road reconstruction

I'm writing to let you know that we'll be continuing our preparation work on the A11 between Spooner Row and the Tuttlles Interchange, ahead of the start of Phase 2 of the scheme in spring 2022. This will require a full closure of the A11 southbound entry slip road at Spooner Row on the following dates:

Southbound - A11 Spooner Row Interchange - southbound entry slip road

- Every evening between 8pm and 6am, from 6 December to 7 December 2021.

During this time any road users who want to join the A11 southbound at Spooner Row will be diverted along the B1172, before turning right onto station road, and then turning left onto Ayton Road and then finally onto Browick Road, before then joining the A11 southbound at the Browick Road junction.

We're also installing temporary traffic lights at the Browick Road junction, in order to allow us to continue our preparation works. The traffic lights will be in place on the following dates:

Browick Road traffic lights

- Every evening between 8pm and 6am, from 6 December to 8 December 2021.

This work will take place overnight so our team can do the work in the safest way possible. This will also allow us to keep the A11 between Spooner Row and the Tuttlles Interchange open during the day. All dates are subject to change due to operational requirements.
