Platinum Jubilee Emblem Competition

Design a Jubilee Emblem for your Town!



Open to all 4-18 year olds living in Attleborough, **OR** attending an Attleborough School. Deadline Monday 28th February. Please read below for further information.

AGE CATEGORIES:

The competition is open to all 4-18 year olds who can enter individually or through their school. Schools can enter in one or more of the following categories

Ages 4-7 (reception, years 1 and 2)

Ages 7-11 (years 3, 4, 5 and 6)

Ages 11-14 (years 7, 8 and 9)

Ages 14-18 (years 10, 11, 12 and 13)

RULES/CRITERIA:

- Artwork submitted must be of an A4 size and two dimensional (by this we mean it should be flat and suitable for framing).
- Entrants can use a range of materials and techniques from the following list: drawing (e.g. pencil, pen, crayon, pastel, etc.), painting, printmaking, collage and montage (photography can be integrated into the piece but we will not accept a standalone photographic entry).
- Work should arrive unmounted and unframed.
- All entries should include the details required on the entry form attached.

JUDGING:

Judging will take place on Monday 28th February Winners will be notified on Tuesday 15th March 2022.

PRIZES:

- The overall competition winner will receive a commemorative trophy and have the honour of Attleborough Town Council adopting their design as the Councils emblem for the Queens Platinum Jubilee Celebrations.
- One winner will be chosen from each age category and presented with a commemorative trophy.
- Runners up will be chosen from each category and presented with a framed certificate acknowledging their placement (2nd or 3rd place).
- All entries will be displayed at the Town Hall throughout the Jubilee weekend.
- All schools and individuals who enter the competition will receive a specially designed certificate in acknowledgement and recognition of their participation.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

By entering the competition, schools and entrants confirm that they have read and understood, and agree to be bound by, the following competition rules:

- The competition is open to all pupils and schools in Attleborough or individuals living in Attleborough that fit the relevant age category.
- Entries must be delivered via post or by hand to:

Attleborough Town Council, Town Hall, Queens Square, Attleborough NR17 2AF

- Entries cannot be delivered electronically and they must be the original artwork.
- Entry to the competition is free, however, all materials for the creation and submission of artwork must be provided by the school or individual.
- All artwork must be the original idea of the entrant and not infringe on anyone else's copyright.
- Entries must be received no later than 4.00pm on 28th February 2022
- School entries Each individual artwork must have the pupil's name and school and school year marked clearly on the back
- Individual entries please ensure your name, age, address and contact telephone number are marked clearly and legibly on the back of your artwork. We are only able to accept one submission per person
- Artwork will not be returned.
- The winners of the competition shall be decided by a panel of judges, and the panel members will be published at a later date. The panel will be looking for creativity, originality and an imaginative response to the theme.
- By entering the competition, entrants give their consent to Attleborough Town Council using their work, free of charge, in any publicity and/or promotional activities. In particular, if an entrant is a winner of the competition, the entrant consents to their name and their winning work being posted on the premises or on the website or social media of the Council. Winners may be asked to be photographed and/or interviewed for publicity purposes.
- The work of entrants will be displayed in the Town Hall from Thursday 2nd June to Monday 6th June 2022
- The Council is not responsible for late, lost or delayed entries.
