Cycle Path Rights of Way

To whom it may concern

Whilst I was pleased to see that a cycle path has been put in along the London road in Attleborough (shared with pedestrians) I was very disappointed to see that there are no rights of way for pedestrians and cyclists. This is particularly of concern for cyclists, especially young children who I regularly see cycling ahead of their parents/Carers as they have to stop at every junction to give way to motorized traffic. This creates potential for accidents and also makes the cycle path pretty much unusable for cyclists unless they are happy to stop every few seconds at each of the many junctions.

I notice that the cycle path along the Newmarket Road in Norwich now gives priority to cyclists across each junction and wonder if this is something that Attleborough Town Council would consider? This would not only make the cycle path much safer for everyone but would also encourage more people to cycle in my opinion. I cycle but don't use the cycle path as I find I am safer on the road as there is more potential for a collision by crossing each road junction.
