

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C139 Bunwell Road from a point 1104m east of its junction with U33095 School Lane for 50m eastwards in the PARISH OF BESTHORPE because of carriageway improvements

This Order continues the provisions of the Order dated 10<sup>th</sup> March 2022 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect on 18<sup>th</sup> March 2022 (previously 14<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> March 2022) for the duration of the works expected to be about 1 day within the period.

Alternative route is via: C139 Bunwell Road, Besthorpe Road, Mile Road, Bunwell Street, B1113 The Turnpike, Norwich Road, Market Place, Queen Street, King Street, Castle Hill Road, B1077 New Buckenham Road, Cake Street, The Green, Attleborough Road, Buckenham Road, Station Road, Surrogate Street, C139 Besthorpe Road and vice versa (Carleton Rode, Attleborough, Bunwell, Besthorpe, New Buckenham, Old Buckenham).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

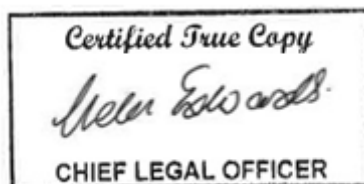
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
