NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the Hargham Road from 20m east of its junction with the A11 slip road to its junction with B1077 The Green in the PARISH OF OLD BUCKENHAM because of carriageway resurfacing works.

The road will be (i) temporarily closed (except for access); and (ii) temporarily subject to a 40mph speed restriction from 11th to 22nd April 2022 for the duration of the works only while signs indicating the restrictions are in place expected to be closure during daytime hours and temporary traffic lights with temporary speed restriction overnight in two phases of 4 days.

Alternative route is via — Road from Snetterton to Old Buckenham, Stone Cross Interchange, A11 From J A1075 to J B1077 West Of Attleborough Ne, A11 Northbound between Snetterton and Attleborough Parish Boundaries, A11 between Quidenham And Besthorpe Parish Boundaries, A11 J B1077 West of Attleborough Roundabout, A11 From J B1077 West Of Attleborough To J B1077 North of Attleborough Ne, A11 through J B1077 North Of Attleborough Ne, A11 J B1077 North of Attleborough Leave Ne, Ellingham Road, Queens Road, Queens Square, Church Street, Surrogate Street, Station Road, Buckenham Road, Attleborough Road, The Green (Attleborough, Old Buckenham).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
