A11 Spooner Row to Tuttle Interchange reconstruction scheme – B1135 closure

I'm writing to provide you with an update regarding the upcoming reconstruction of the road on this stretch of the A11.

We'll need to close the B1135 road that connects the Tuttle Interchange from the Spinks Lane roundabout to the B1172 Waitrose roundabout, each night (8pm to 6am, Monday to Friday) from 4 July 2022 to 15 July 2022. The closures will allow our teams to install a new drainage system and clear the vegetation at this location so that we can proceed with the work.

We're unable to carry out this work during the day, as we need to completely close the road to keep the public and our team safe while the work takes place. Therefore, we've decided to complete the work overnight when the amount of traffic is at its lowest. We apologise in advance for any disturbance caused by our activity. Rest assured, we'll do our best to keep any disruption down to a minimum.

When the B1135 is closed each night, customers will be invited to access Wymondham by joining the B1172 at Thickthorn.

Keeping the community updated

We've sent a letter discussing the above to every home within a 500m of the scheme, so we can ensure that the local communities who will be impacted by our activity have been informed. We've also provided them with a 24/7 telephone number and email address for the project, so they can get in contact if required.
