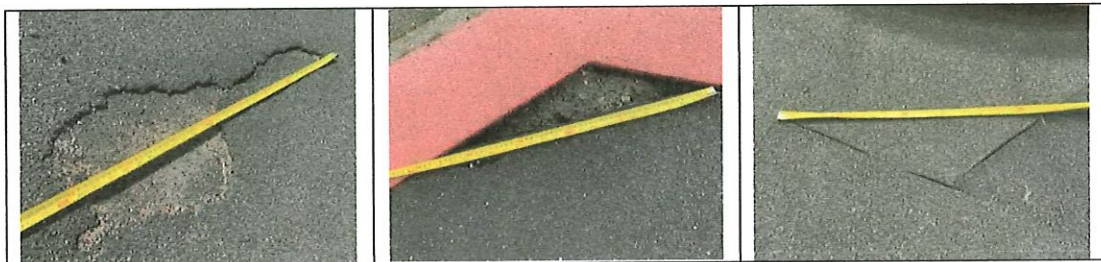

Wetpour Edge Repairs



Wet Pour band perimeter shrinkage repairs are very common especially on older wetpour surfaces. EPDM rubber crumb is prone to shrinkage and expansion in adverse weather conditions especially the older the surface gets as the rubber loses its elasticity. The shrinkage of the rubber usually pulls away from the perimeter edge leaving a gap which often forms a trip hazard or an unsightly place for weed growth. These common issues are easily rectified with a wet pour band repair.

Band repairs are easily carried out by our specialist surfacing installation team. The perimeter shrinkage usually needs to be cut back so that the existing rubber crumb has a sharp edge to install up against too. The exposed stone base works is redressed, rubber edges primed with the void then being filled with a contrasting EPDM wetpour rubber band often making the area look as a new graphic has been installed. Contrasting colours are used as it is very hard to match colours in especially where existing surfaces have been exposed to wear and tear for a few years.

The following assumptions have been made regarding this estimate:

- ✚ Good access will be available to the site.

- ✚ Security fencing can be supplied and erected at extra cost if deemed necessary by the customer.

- ✚ Suspension bridges, Burma bridges, single ropes and access nets are designed for a maximum of 1 person crossing at any one time; however additional people can be waiting to cross on the timber structures.

 - Timbers cannot be guaranteed against rot and decay when installed into loose fill wood product surfacing.
 - The bond between old and new rubber on wetpour edge repairs is excluded from guarantees due to the un-known nature of the existing rubber
 - In the case of Black Wetpour surfacing, colour fastness cannot be guaranteed, and some colour leakage may occur.

- The colour of our Fibrefall surfacing will darken after a period of time as the vibrancy of the colour coating diminishes.
- 1 Year on all moving and flexible parts including ropes and nets. 1 Year on all installation work (*Malicious damage, vandalism and acts of god are not covered*)

Hi Anne,

Thank you for the enquiry, please find expected ballpark figures for the resurfacing as follows, all figures are + VAT and includes the design, supply and installation :-

- Octagon Area Rubber Mulch - £7,500
- Octagon Area EPDM - £9,600
- Monkey Bar Area Rubber Mulch - £750
- Monkey Bar Area EPDM - £1,150

EPDM is the traditional wetpour product and is typically slightly harder wearing than rubber mulch, however rubber mulch does use exactly the same binder as EPDM and is also typically used as a fall attenuating surface for play areas. Please come back to us after your meeting and we can do our best to fit you into our current working schedule.

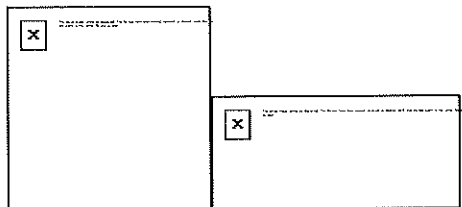
