

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the 1) **B1077 Buckenham Road** from its junction with U33089 Borough Lane for 40m southwards in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH; 2) **C138 Hargham Road** from its junction with U33088 The Green to its junction with C138 Road from Snetterton to Old Buckenham; and 3) **C138 Road from Snetterton to Old Buckenham** from its junction with C138 to its junction with the A11 in the PARISH OF OLD BUCKENHAM because of electric connection works.

The road 1) will be temporarily closed and the roads 2) and 3) will be subject to the temporary suspension of the 7.5T weight restriction from 22nd to 25th August 2022 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 4 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Northbound – B1077 Buckenham Road/Attleborough Road/The Green, C138 The Green/Hargham Road/Road from Snetterton to Old Buckenham, A11, B1077 Ellingham Road/Queens Road/Queens Square/Church Street/Surrogate Street/Station Road; Southbound – B1077 Station Road/Connaught Road/Connaught Plain/Queens Road, A11, C138 Road from Snetterton to Old Buckenham/Hargham Road/The Green, B1077 The Green/Attleborough Road/Buckenham Road.

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

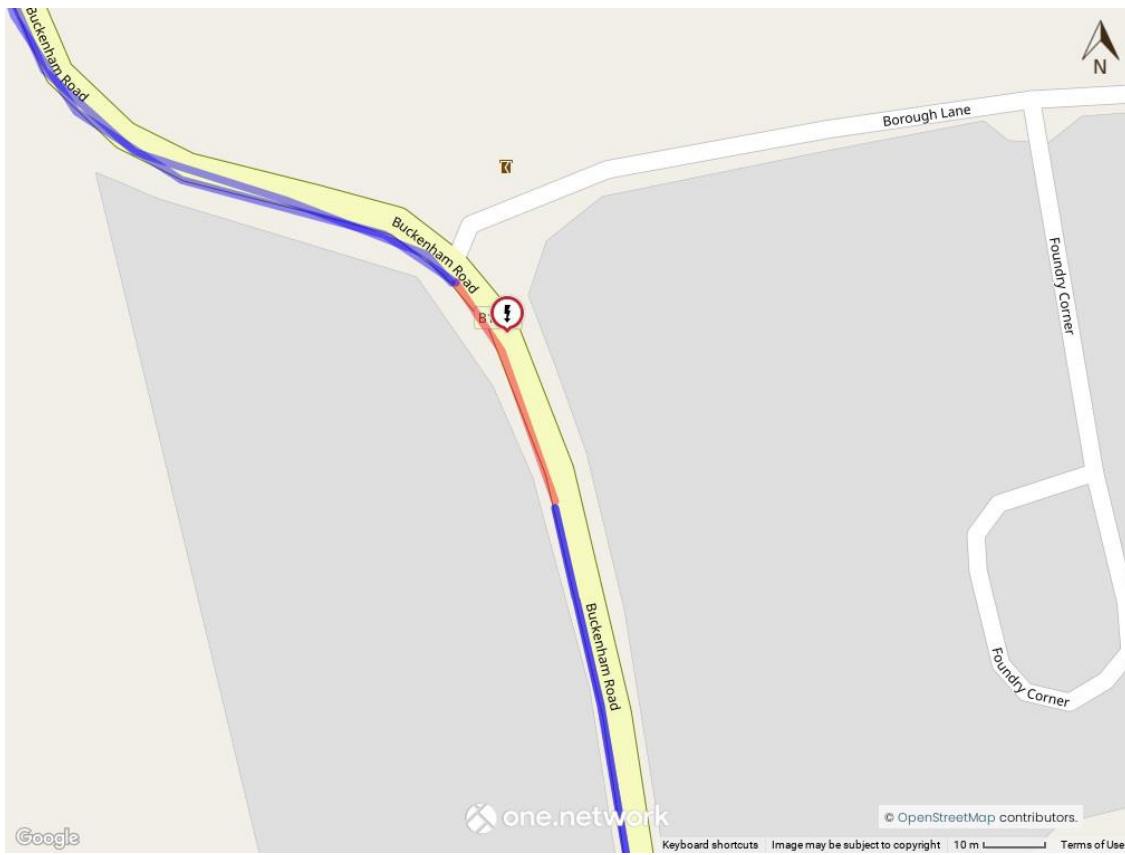
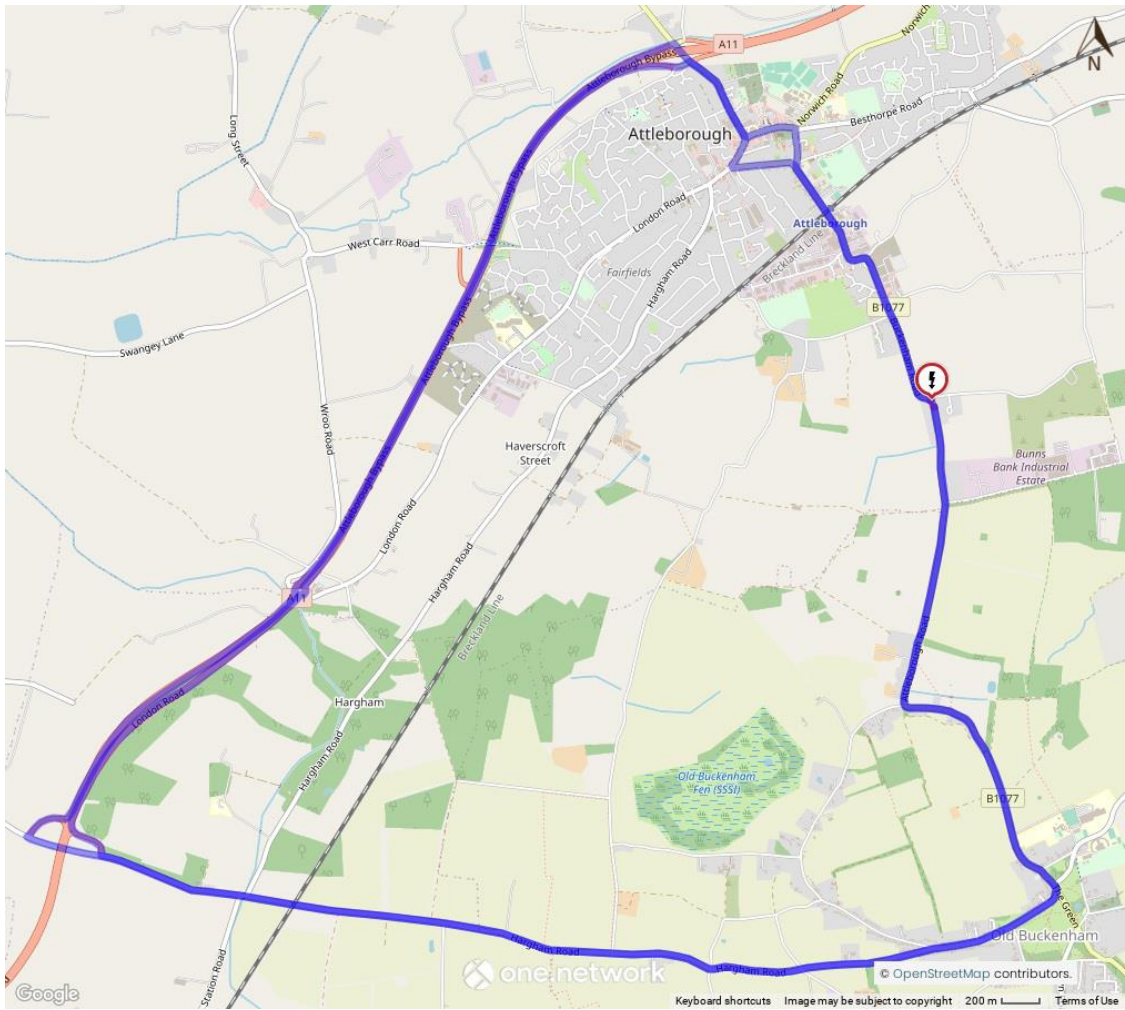
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
