A11 Spooner Row to Tuttle Interchange reconstruction scheme – Closure of Northbound Contraflow Lane

I'm writing to let you know that we're planning on closing the northbound contraflow lane on the evening of 30 August 2022, between the hours of 8pm and 6am.

The closure will allow us to complete some routine maintenance of the lane, alongside safety critical work adjacent to the barrier.

This work will take place overnight so our team can do the work in the safest way possible. This will also allow us to keep the A11 between Spooner Row and the Tuttle Interchange open during the day. The routine maintenance is not expected to be noisy, and we'll do our best to complete the work as quickly as possible, however all dates are subject to change due to operational requirements.

Customers wanting to travel northbound on the A11 will be invited to travel along the A1066, before joining the A140 northbound, and then the A47 towards Thickthorn. The diversion will be clearly signposted, and a map can be found on the following page.
