## Norfolk County Council (Old Buckenham) (Emergency Notice) Temporary Traffic Restriction 2022 Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to communication pipe repair works the use by vehicles of the C138 Hargham Road from 225m east of its junction with Leys Lane for 20m eastwards in the PARISH OF OLD BUCKENHAM will be temporarily prohibited from 15<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> August 2022 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 10 days within the period. If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.

Alternative route is via: Hargham Road, Road from Snetterton to Old Buckenham, Access Roads in and around Hargham Hall, High Street, Connaught Plain, Exchange Street, Queens Square, Queens Road, Church Street, Surrogate Street, Station Road, Buckenham Road, Attleborough Road, The Green (Attleborough, Old Buckenham, Quidenham).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
