

**A11 Spooner Row to Tuttle Interchange reconstruction scheme – Closure of Northbound Contraflow Lane**

I'm writing to let you know that we're planning on closing the northbound contraflow lane each evening between the hours of 8pm and 6am, from 26 September to 30 September 2022. We'll also need to close the B1135 each evening between the hours of 8pm and 6am, from 3 October to 7 October, and then from 10 October to 14 October.

The closures are needed so we can install new manholes into the carriageway. This will take place overnight so our team can work in the safest way possible, while allowing us to keep the A11 road between Spooner Row and Tuttle Interchange open during the day. The work is not expected to be noisy, and we'll do our best to complete it as quickly as possible, however all dates are subject to change due to operational requirements.

The diversion will be clearly signposted, and a map can be found on the following page. Customers wanting to travel northbound on the A11 will be directed to travel along the A1066, before joining the A140 northbound, and then the A47 towards Thickthorn.

When the B1135 is closed each night, customers will not be able to exit the A11 southbound at the Tuttle Interchange. Instead, they will be directed to access Wymondham by joining the B1172 at Thickthorn.
