

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the 1) C572 Connaught Plain from its junction with B1077 Connaught Road to its junction with C572 High Street; and 2) C572 High Street from its junction with C572 Connaught Plain for 30m westwards in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH because of gas main works.

The roads will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 24th October to 10th November 2022 for the duration of the works expected to be about 18 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: **Eastbound** - C572 High Street/ London Road, A11, B1077 Ellingham Road/ Queens Road/ Queens Square/ Church Street/ Surrogate Street/ Connaught Road. **Westbound** - B1077 Connaught Plain/ Exchange Street/ Queens Road, U33119 Blackthorn Road, A11, C572 London Road/ High Street.

(If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
