

The Norfolk County Council
(Attleborough, B1077 Norwich Road)
30mph Speed Limit Order 2022

The Norfolk County Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from exceeding 30 miles per hour along the length of the B1077 Norwich Road from its junction with the B1077 Church Street north-eastwards for a distance of 1,350 metres. This is a reduction of the current 40mph speed limit and an extension to the 30mph speed limit of 830m.

For clarity and administrative purposes The Norfolk County Council (Attleborough, Various Roads) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2013 and The Norfolk County Council (Attleborough, Various Roads) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Consolidation Order 2019 are revoked insofar as they refer to B1077 Norwich Road in their respective Schedules.

However, during the current epidemic staffing levels have been reduced and viewing online would be recommended in keeping with the government guidelines.

Any objections and representations relating to the Order must be made in writing and must specify the grounds on which they are made.
