

**A11 Spooner Row to Tuttle Interchange Reconstruction Scheme
– Browick Junction Local Diversion Route**

I'm writing to let you know that we've been contacted by a number of residents and local councillors about the amount of traffic travelling along Blackthorn Road and Holly Blue Road, also known as the Harts Farm Estate, to access the B1172.

We know that diversions are challenging, with few alternative routes available, but we've worked with Norfolk County Council to make sure the safest and most appropriate route is used and is properly signed.

However, HGVs have been spotted using the incorrect route when travelling from the Browick junction into Wymondham, despite signs being in place stating that it's to be used for local access only.

As a result, we've installed additional signs to help guide road users along the correct diversion, and to reinforce the 20mph speed limit through the estate. We'll continue to engage with local haulage companies to encourage their drivers to use the correct diversion, as this remains the safest option for them and local residents.

If you have any HGVs visiting or making deliveries to your organisation who might use the Browick junction, then please could you ask them to use the signed diversion.

We appreciate your ongoing patience while we reconstruct this section of the A11.
