

A11 Spooner Row to Tuttle Interchange reconstruction scheme – Southbound closures

I'm writing to let you know that we're planning to close the Browick southbound entry slip road on the evenings of 21 and 22 November 2022, and then again, each evening from 28 November to 2 December 2022 between 8pm and 6am.

The closures allow us to complete drainage survey works, as well as additional repair works. There will also be 2-way traffic lights over the Browick junction during this time.

Doing the work overnight when traffic is lighter means our teams can work in the safest way possible and avoids disruption on this stretch of the A11 during the day. We'll do our best to complete the work as quickly as possible, however all dates are subject to change due to operational requirements.

This activity at times may be noisy, and we'd like to apologise in advance for any disturbance caused. We'll instruct our teams to do their best to keep any disruption down to a minimum.

During this time, traffic wishing to travel southbound on the A11 from the Browick junction will be diverted along Browick Road, before joining the B1172 towards Attleborough, and then rejoining the A11 southbound at the Spooner Row junction. You can find a map of the diversion route at the end of this letter.

Keeping the community updated

We've sent a letter discussing the above to every home within a 500m of the scheme, so we can ensure that the local communities who will be impacted by our activity have been informed. We've also provided them with a 24/7 telephone number and email address for the project, so they can get in contact if required.
