

**Norfolk County Council
(Attleborough) (Emergency Notice)
Temporary Traffic Restriction 2022
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to burst water main repairs the use by vehicles of the U33125 Blacksmith Lane from its junction with C572 London Road for 30m southwards in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH will be temporarily prohibited from 30th November to 5th December 2022 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 6 days within the period. If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.

Alternative route is via: U33125 Blacksmith Lane, C153 Hargham Road, U33124 New Road, C572 London Road and vice versa (Attleborough, Quidenham).

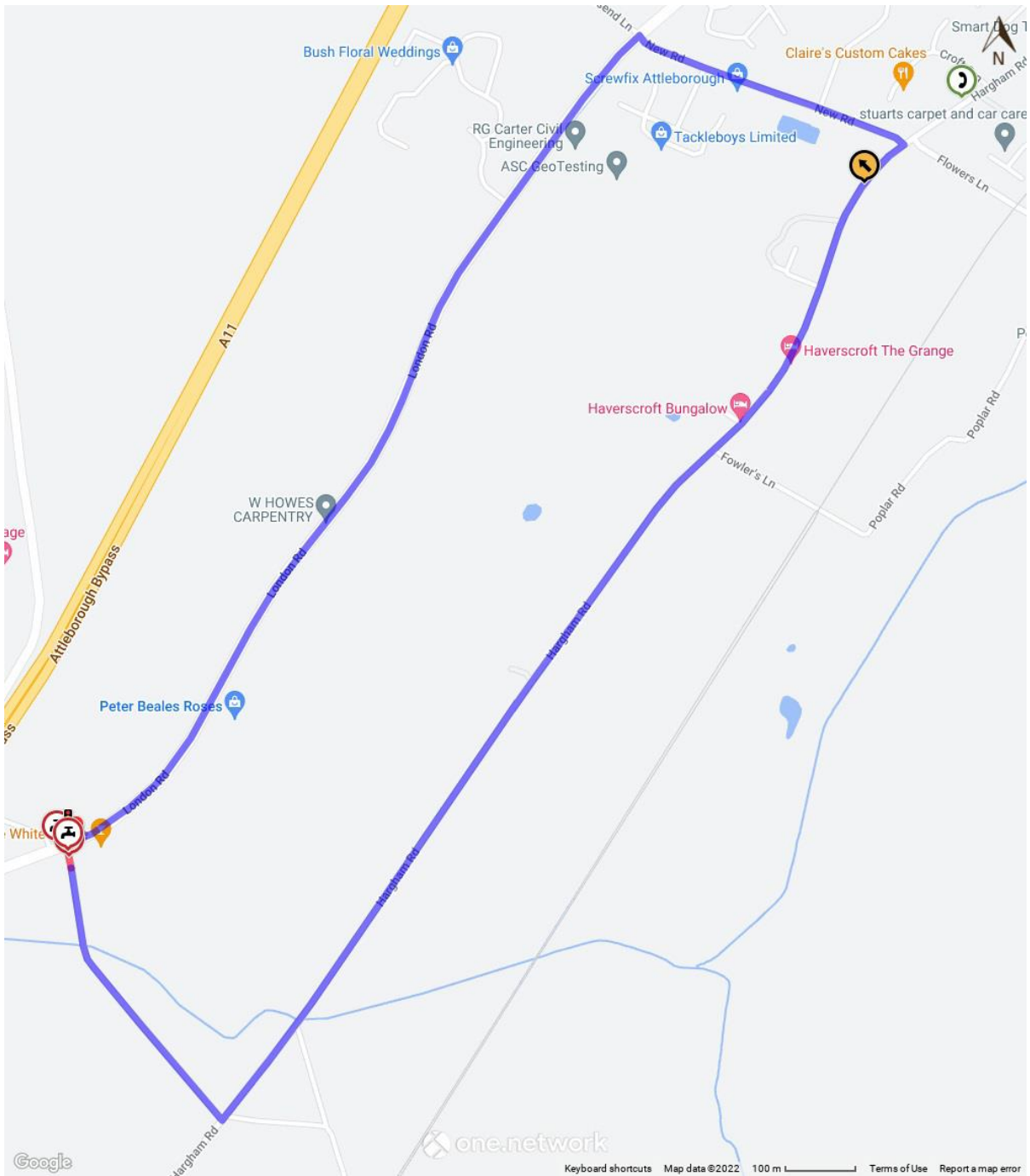
(If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
