

**Norfolk County Council  
(Attleborough) (Emergency Notice)  
Temporary Traffic Restriction 2022  
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to Anglian Water sluice valve repairs the use by vehicles of the U33089 Borough Lane from its junction with B1077 Buckenham Road for 20m eastwards in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH will be temporarily prohibited from 11<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> December 2022 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 6 days within the period. If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.

Alternative route is via: U33089 Borough Lane, U33091 Long Lane, U33090 Burgh Common, B1077 Buckenham Road and vice versa.

(If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
