

**Norfolk County Council  
(Attleborough) (Emergency Notice)  
Temporary Traffic Restriction 2022  
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to burst water main repairs the use by vehicles of the C136 Long Street from 550m southeast of its junction with U33112 Penhill Road for 50m south-eastwards in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH will be temporarily prohibited from 14<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> December 2022 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 7 days within the period. If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.

Alternative route is via: **Southbound** - C136 Long Street/Chequers Lane, B1077 Attleborough Road/Ellingham Road/Queens Road/Queens Square/Church Street/Surrogate Street/Connaught Road, C572 Connaught Plain/High Street/London Road, A11 Great Ellingham London Road roundabout, C136 Wroo Road. **Northbound** - C136 Long Street/Wroo Road/A11 Great Ellingham London Road roundabout, C572 London Road/High Street/Connaught Plain, B1077 Exchange Street/Queens Road/Ellingham Road/Attleborough Road, C136 Chequers Lane/Long Street (Attleborough, Great Ellingham).

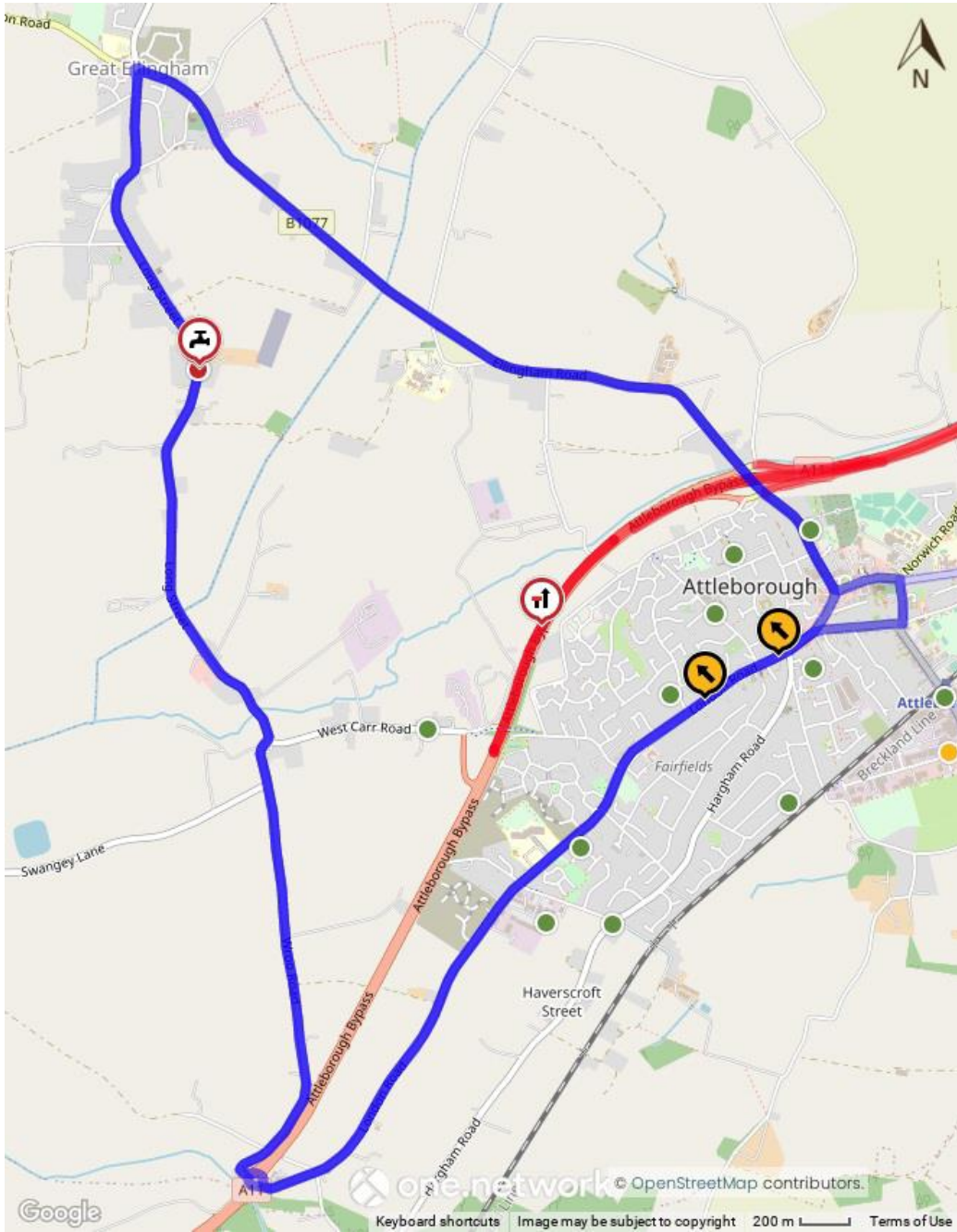
(If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
