

**Norfolk County Council  
(Attleborough) (Emergency Notice)  
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023  
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)**

Notice (STRO7855)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to Anglian Water leaking communication pipe repairs the use by vehicles of the C153 Hargham Road from 48m southwest of its junction with U33389 Fairfield Drive for 30m south westwards in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH will be temporarily prohibited from 18<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> January 2023 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 7 days within the period.

This Notice has a maximum duration of 21 days. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Notice, the operational period of this Notice may become extended by issuing an Order or further Notice to allow completion of the works for a maximum duration of 18 months.

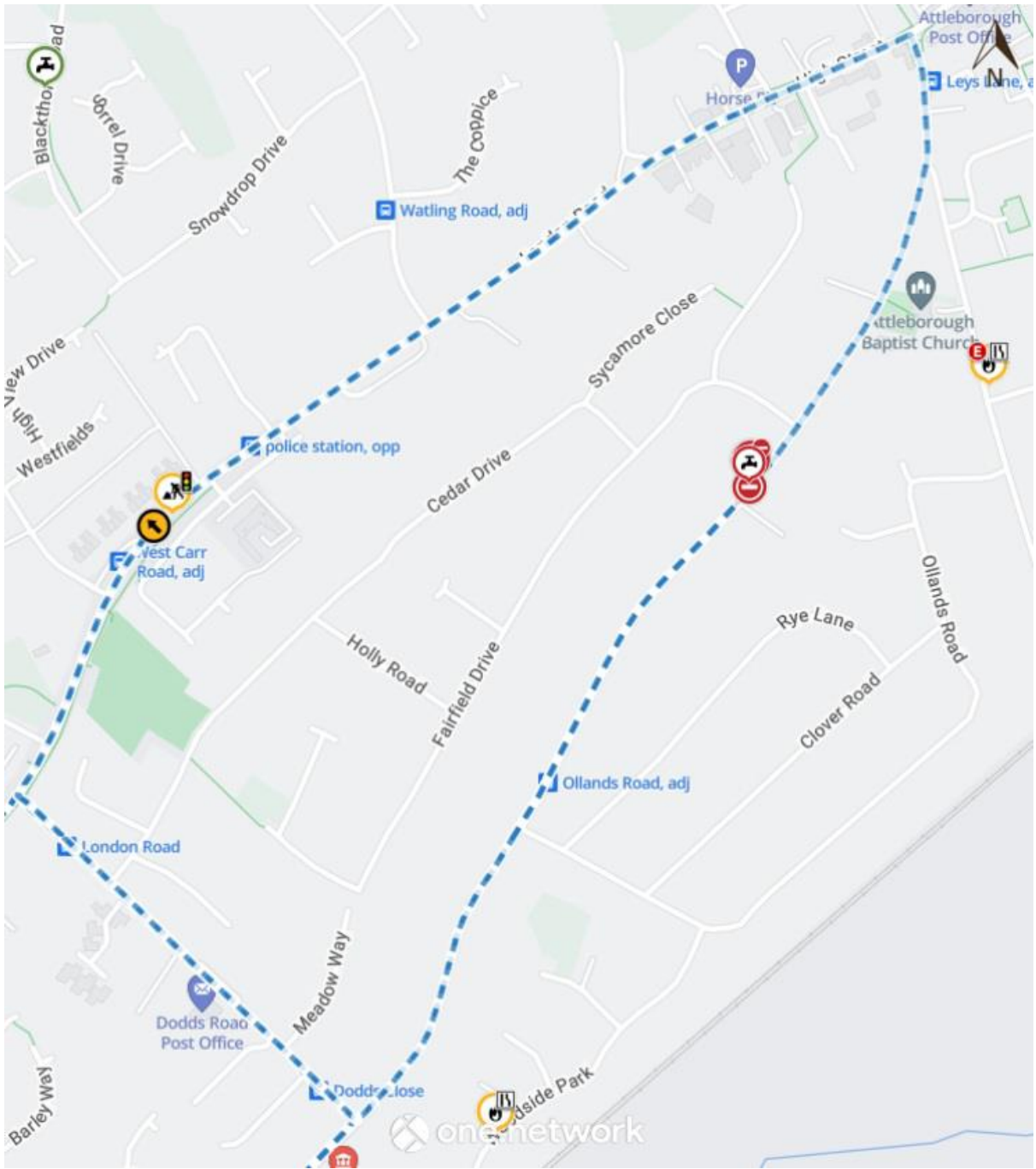
Alternative route is via: C153 Hargham Road, U33123 Dodds Road, C572 London Road / High Street and vice versa.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
