

## A11 Spooner Row to Tuttle Interchange reconstruction scheme

### Advanced notification of closure of Wymondham Road and additional northbound A11 closure - A11 Spooner Row to Tuttle Interchange reconstruction scheme

I'm writing to let you know that we'll need to close Wymondham Road between 9am and 11am on 16 and 17 January 2023, as part of our ongoing A11 road reconstruction scheme.

The closure will allow us to deliver some large equipment into a farmer's field, which will then be used for drainage work on the northbound side of the carriageway. As Wymondham Road is a rather thin country road, it won't be possible for any oncoming vehicles to pass the vehicle needed to deliver the equipment. This is why it's safer to close the road for a couple of hours to allow the equipment to arrive. Please note that Sutton Lane and Chapel Road, which are located either side of Wymondham Road, will remain open throughout this period – please see the map at the end of this bulletin.

A diversion route will be in place during this time, which will invite road users to travel along Station Road, and then join Chepore Lane, before reaching Sutton Lane.

### Additional northbound A11 closure – 10 January 2023

We're planning to close the A11 northbound between Attleborough and the Tuttle Interchange on the evening of 10 January 2023.

The closure will take place between 8pm and 6am, and will allow us to complete critical work ahead of the traffic management switch on the evening of 11 January.

Customers wanting to travel northbound on the A11 will be diverted along the A1066, before joining the A140 northbound, and then the A47 towards Thickethorn.

All dates are subject to change due to operational requirements and weather.
