

A11 Spooner Row to Tuttles Interchange reconstruction scheme

Advanced notification of the overnight closure of the A11 northbound entry slip road at Browick Road / Mulbarton junction

I'm writing to let you know that we'll be closing the northbound entry slip road at the Browick Road / Mulbarton junction for two nights on Thursday 2 March and Friday 3 March 2023, from 8pm until 6am each night.

This is so we can carry out some essential drainage work with the use of CCTV equipment. By carrying out the work in this way, we will avoid digging up the road. The existing drainage will be repaired using trenchless technology with robotic instruments within the drainpipe. The robotic instruments will be inserted into the drainage chambers and the operatives will control the robots from within their trucks.

To ensure the safety of our workers and help keep disruption to a minimum, we'll be doing this work overnight when there is typically less traffic on the road. We're sorry for any disturbance caused by our activity and for any delays encountered as a result of this work.

In addition to this work, there is also some urgent repair work being carried out on the A11 northbound between the Tuttles Interchange to Thickthorn Interchange (Hethersett Bypass), each night from Monday 27 February 2023 to Friday 17 March. More information about this work can be found on our scheme webpage.

For this reason, our usual diversion route has been temporarily changed. Traffic wishing to join the A11 northbound will be diverted along Browick Road, and then onto Ayton Road, before heading north on the B1172 to the Thickthorn Interchange. A fully signed diversion route will be in place, and we've included a copy of the diversion route map at the end of this letter.
