Northbound - C153 Hargham Road, C572 High Street/ Connaught Plain, B1077 Connaught Plain/Exchange Street/ Queens Square/ Church Street/ Surrogate Street/ Station Road/ Buckenham Road/ Attleborough Road/ The Green, C138 The Green/ Hargham Road/ Road from Snetterton to Old Buckenham (Attleborough, Old Buckenham, Quidenham).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
