Advanced notification of upcoming work on the A11 concrete roads scheme

I'm writing to provide you with an update on the reconstruction of the A11 carriageway between Spooner Row and the Tuttle Interchange at Wymondham.

Change of date - Closure of Spooner Row southbound entry slip road, opening of Tuttle southbound entry slip road and A11 northbound closures scheduled for Thursday 27 and Friday 28 April 2023

We previously wrote to you to let you know that we'd be closing Spooner Row southbound entry slip road at 6am on Tuesday 2 May 2023, while the A11 northbound between Attleborough and Thickthorn would be closed overnight, so we can continue carrying out repairs on the carriageway.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, these dates will now need to be changed, as below:

- Tuesday 2 May 2023 - overnight closure of A11 **southbound** between Thickthorn and Attleborough. These closures will take place from 8pm to 6am each night.
- Wednesday 3 May 2023 – **Spooner Row southbound entry slip road** will be closed from 6am until mid-summer 2023
- Wednesday 3 May 2023 – the **Tuttle Interchange southbound entry slip road**, will be re-opened at 6am on Wednesday 3 May. Traffic will be diverted to follow the B1172 through Wymondham, before joining the A11 southbound at the Tuttle Interchange
- Thursday 4 May and Friday 5 May - overnight closure of A11 **northbound** between Attleborough and Thickthorn. These closures will take place from 8pm to 6am each night.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused by the above changes.

Diversion route

A clearly signed diversion route will be in place during these closures. Road users wishing to travel southbound will be diverted on the A11 to travel eastbound from the Thickthorn roundabout along the A47, before travelling southbound on the A140, and then westbound on the A1066 towards Thetford, before re-joining the A11.

Customers wishing to travel northbound on the A11 will be directed westbound at Thetford along the A1066, before then travelling northbound on the A140 towards Norwich, and then westbound on the A47 to the Thickthorn roundabout.

Keeping the community informed

We'll be using specialist equipment to carry out this work, so customers may hear more noise than usual. We've written to every property within a 500-metre radius of this work to inform them of the potential disruption this may cause, and we'll make every effort to carefully manage noise levels to minimise the impact.

We're sorry for the disruption this work may cause to your journey and encourage drivers to plan ahead and allow extra time when travelling. We'll aim to reopen the roads sooner if we complete our work earlier than expected. Please note that these closures are subject to change at short notice due to unforeseen circumstances or poor weather conditions.
