

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (STRO9341) affecting the B1077 Watton Road from its junction with C136 Hingham Road to its junction with U33143 Bow Street in the PARISH OF GREAT ELLINGHAM to facilitate surface dressing works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between (i) 19:00 and 06:00 from 10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> July 2023; (ii) 09:00 and 16:00 from 12<sup>th</sup> July to 13<sup>th</sup> 2023; and (iii) 19:00 and 06:00 from 13<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2023 for the duration of the works, only while signs indicating the closure are in place.

Alternative route is via: B1077, A11, A1075, B1108, B1077 (Thompson, Carbrooke, Hockham, Griston, Roudham and Larling, Shropham, Snetterton, Scoulton, Merton, Caston, Rocklands, Attleborough, Great Ellingham, Quidenham, Watton, Stow Bedon and Breckles).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

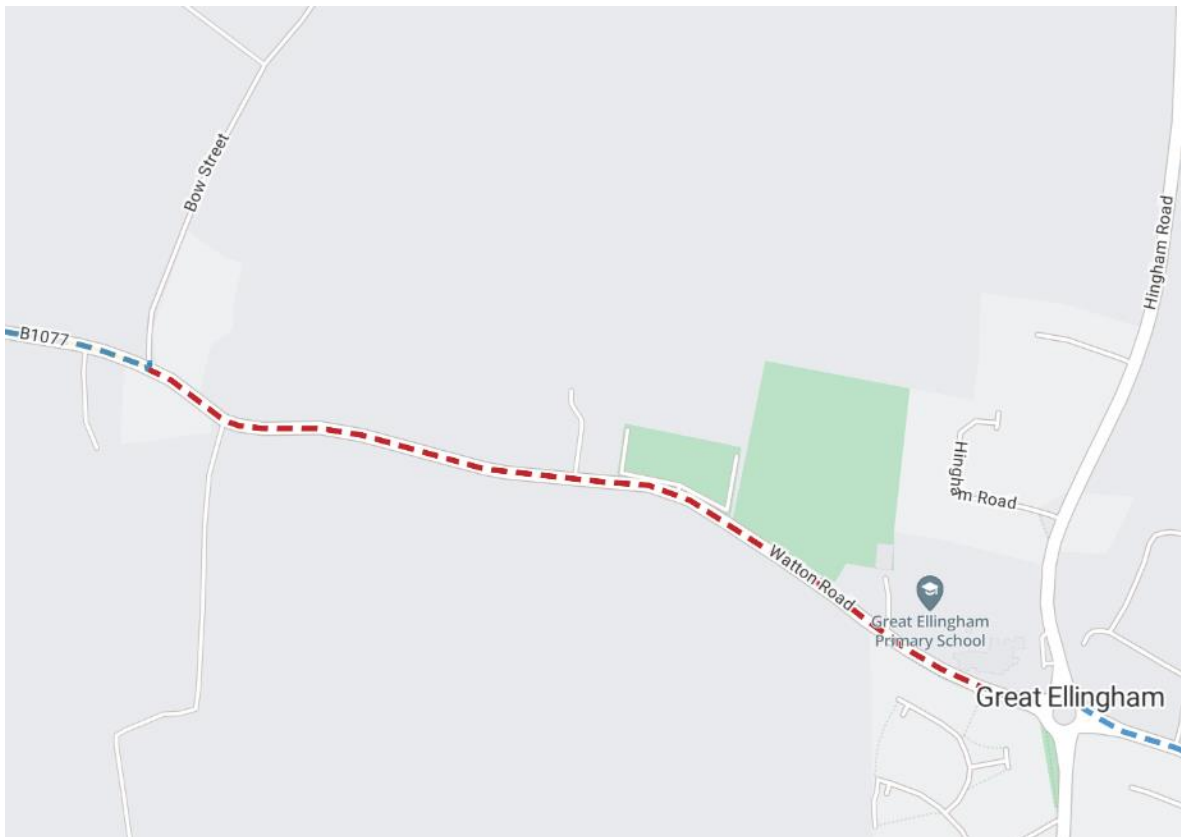
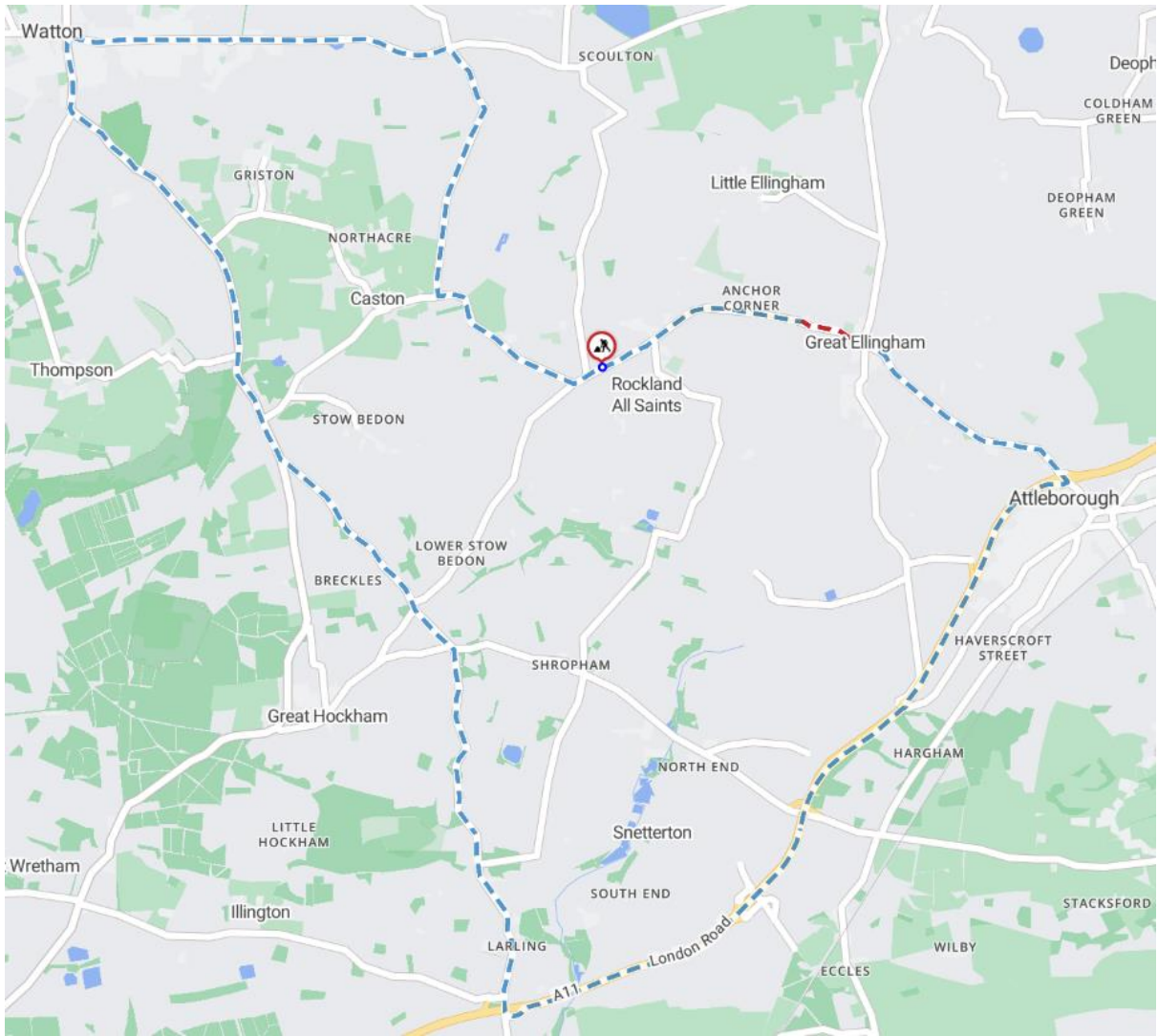
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
